Where we have been.

- 2000- No regulations, 200 plus Wildlife Rehabbers
- 2006- Regulations (Conditions of Authorizations) fully come into effect
- 2010- over 10 years loss of major centers (Ottawa Calton, Earth Rangers, Solitudes, Second Chance)
- 2008- MNR stake holders meeting Toronto
- 2009- Ministerial Advisory Committee (only one meeting than collapsed)
- 2011- Estimated around 100 Wildlife Rehabbers in Province (OWR)
- 2017- Monique, ADM-ROD) attends Rehabber Meeting (Monique's list created), 70 Rehabbers in province.
- 2018- Right of Appeal given by Minister with support of Monique
- 2019- Annual meeting Brampton, Adam heads MNR delegation, 60 Rehabbers in province
- 2021- MNR/Rehabbers survey taken, census 55 Rehabbers (52 Ont. 3 Can.)
- 2022- Annual meeting Virtual, Minister attended, census 54 (51 Ont. 3 Can)
